- Strong verbal and written English proficiency
- Willingness to work overtime, on call, particularly during raining season

There's no doubt that you'll face some challenges; but you will be up for it because of your strong work ethic, and pride in your work. The workweek is Monday to Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., 40 hours per week. Ability to work some overtime after hours or be on call on the weekends, especially during our rainy/ busy season (September to April), is necessary as well as the ability to work out of town in Western Canada 60% of the time. (For out-of-town work, we provide transportation, daily meal allowance and accommodations.)
